SATELLITE LOCATION AND TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

Our Satellite is hosted at the CJDS/ JCC building on :
150 East Dublin Granville Road St. New Albany.

Our Schedule during the week:

Grades 3-6 meet on Mondays and Wednesdays, 4-6 PM. (and on Sundays at Broad St Location)

Grades 2 and 7 on Wednesdays, 4-6 PM (and on Sundays at Broad St Location)

Our students will need to be transported after school from the New Albany schools to the Satellite on Mondays and Wednesdays, **starting on September 27th**. Tifereth Israel will have staff available at CJDS location at 3:30.

Since CJDS is in session until 3:35, Satellite students arriving before 3:35 will need to be enrolled in one of the new [JCC after-school programs](#), conveniently designed to assist our students and parents. Please see details below.

New Albany / Plain City schools will provide transportation for our New Albany students with parental request and permission.

1. The Elementary school students will ride Bus #20 and will be dropped at CJDS/JCC building approximately 3:45 pm.
2. Middle school students can arrive to satellite after 3:35 with parental carpool. OR: Parents can **request the school to have a bus stop at JCC with the [Designated Bus Stop Request Form](#)**, such that kids will arrive approximately at 2:35 pm. and will have to enroll in the JCC ***Sababa Middle School Club*** for relaxation, homework and snack. **Please see attached flyer and registration forms and submit [directly to the JCC](#) according to the instructions.**
