**Mid-Ohio Food Bank - Donate (currently staffed through the National Guard)**

We have created the COVID-19 Emergency Fund to acquire and distribute more food and supplies to continue to meet the needs of our current customers, while also addressing the rising need as job opportunities are impacted by this crisis. With the unprecedented shutdown of schools, large portions of the hospitality industry and many other aspects of normal life, we anticipate an increased demand for food in our community. While we typically provide enough food for 150,000+ meals each day and serve more than 500,000 customers annually across our 20-county service area, we expect these numbers to increase significantly in the weeks and months ahead.

**Community Shelter Board - Donate/Volunteer**

More than 1,200 people sleep in homeless shelters in Columbus and Franklin County on any given night, while an estimated 600 or more are on the streets. Community Shelter Board is leading a battle to slow the spread of COVID-19 among people experiencing homelessness. These efforts including opening multiple new facilities – some to achieve social distancing in crowded homeless shelters, and other facilities for isolation and quarantine of those already infected with the virus.

**Coalition on Homelessness and Housing in Ohio - Donate**

The lives of more than 10,000 Ohioans in 300 homeless shelters around the state are at imminent risk from the coronavirus. Please support the COHHIO Pandemic Emergency Fund so our homeless shelters get the cleaning supplies, medical equipment, extra staffing and space they need during this crisis. Emergency shelters operate on lean budgets and are struggling to meet basic needs while trying to prevent the spread of infection. Social distancing is impossible without a place to call home. Our recent report found 87% don't have enough space to isolate and quarantine clients, and 71% don't have enough cleaning and hygiene supplies to prevent the spread of the virus. Shelters are losing desperately needed staff and volunteers.
